## MINUTES OF THE DDC MEETING HELD ON 07-05-2023 AT 10:30 AM IN THE OFFICE CONFERENCE HALL OF THE DEPUTY COMMISSSIONER, GOLAGHAT FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL/2023

The meeting was held in presence of Heads of various Development Departments of the District and Chaired by Dr. P. Uday Praveen, IAS, Golaghat.

At the very outset the Deputy Commissioner, Golaghat welcomed the members present in the meeting and asked the departments concerned to submit the detailed report for the action points of DCs conference held at Tezpur for the upcoming DCs conference to be held at Tinsukia. He also urged all the Heads of Departments to include the target date of completion in scheme list.

The chairman informed the House that from next DDC meeting onwards concerned ADCs will present the Departmental issue directly in consultation with Heads of Departments.

After that the meeting discussed sector wise progress elaborately and emphasized on the following aspects:

Commissioner, Taxes for achieving 106% of the targeted Tax Amount.</li> <li>A.C, Taxation informed the house that due to shut-down activities of NRL this year tax collection may be impacted.</li> <li>DC, Golaghat suggested A.C, Taxation to prepare and submit a comprehensive plan on how the current FY ie 2023-24 tax target could be achieved.</li> <li>A.C, Taxes informed the house that the time to submit Professional Tax is within September, 2023. If the submission rate is not satisfactory then a P. Tax collection drive will also be conducted to cover up any slippage.</li> </ul>
3	Sericulture	<ul> <li>Asstt. Director, Sericulture informed the house that the scheme under APART has already been approved.</li> </ul>





4	Veterinary	He also informed that approval for the Samagra-II scheme has no yet been received.  DC, Golaghat asked Asstt. Director, Sericulture to submit a worl break-up report on Bagidhala Plantation convergence project under NRL CSR fund at Bogidhala and also said that he will physically visit the site before inauguration of the project.  Regarding Bagidhala encroachment issue DC, Golaghat asked the concerned ADC to take report from Circle Officer concerned.  DC, Golaghat asked the Asstt. Commissioner concerned to visit the Tea Gardens to look into the over use of pesticides which affects the cocoon production.  DC, Golaghat asked DVO, Golaghat to prepare and submit monthly target of vaccination to be done.  The chairman also asked DVO, Golaghat to submit list of no. of vaccine available expiry date wise.  In the next DDC meeting KCC matter will be discussed with LDM, Golaghat.  The chairman also urged to complete the vaccination drive before vaccines expire.  DVO, Golaghat informed the house that only SC/ST population are eligible under Production of Fooder scheme. He iterated that the no. of eligible SC/ST beneficiaries are not enough and therefore this scheme could be extended to other communities also. He also informed that the land required for the scheme is 1 Bigha and some of the eligible ones do not want to use the land for this purpose and some do not have land also. On this DC, Golaghat deliberated that land could be leased out to the landless beneficiaries for the scheme and since the scheme is seasonal one, land provided could be used for other purpose only. In this regard, the Chairman asked DVO, Golaghat to submit list of landless eligible beneficiaries.
