**Order under Section 163 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023**

**Subject: Prohibition of Entry within 100 Meters radius of Nomination Centres in connection with Panchayat Election, 2025.**

Whereas, it is necessary to issue order under Section 163 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 to prohibit the entry of any person other than the candidates and officials engaged for conduct and monitoring of nomination on the days of nomination in and around 100 meters of Nomination centers;

Whereas, it is essential to ensure the smooth and fair conduct of the Nomination process in connection with Panchayat Election, 2025;

Whereas, there is an apprehension of breach of peace and public tranquillity due to large gathering and well wishers of candidates around the nomination centres;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 163 of the **Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (B.N.S.S)**, I, Shri Pulak Mahanta, ACS, District Magistrate, Golaghat, do hereby orders to prohibit the following throughout the district of Golaghat:

- ***Entry of unauthorized persons or unnecessary crowd around the premises of Nomination Centers and within 100 meters radius of the centre premises.***
- ***Entry of unauthorized persons inside the premises of Nomination Centres.***
- ***Carrying of any weapon, explosives or any other suspicious objects within 100 metre radius of nomination Centres.***
- ***Obstruction of traffic, entry and illegal parking of unauthorized vehicles within 100 metre radius of Nomination Centres.***
- ***Brusting of crackers within 100 metre radius of nomination Centres.***

The Superintendent of Police, Golaghat will deploy police personnel at the nomination centres as per requirement and get these orders implemented in letter and spirit.

In view of the emergent situation this order is passed ex-parte and addressed to the public in general.

Any person aggrieved by this order may approach the undersigned for exemption/ alteration etc. of this order.

Any violation of these order shall be liable to be prosecuted under Sec.223 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita , 2023.

This order will come into force with immediate effect and will remain in force until nomination process for Panchayat Election, 2025 is over.
