The meeting was Chaired by the District Commissioner, Shri Pulak Mahanta, ACS with District Heads of Development Department of Golaghat District and others.

At the very outset the District Commissioner, Golaghat, Shri Pulak Mahanta, ACS, welcomed all the members present in the meeting and thanked all HODs for their active cooperation towards smooth flood relief and rescue operation during recent flood and also thanked for their untiring efforts which make the Golaghat District a performer district of Assam with ranking 2(two) slacked only by 0.5 to achieve rank 1(one) and hoped HODs will put their efforts for saturation of KPIs. D.C. also hoped that HODs will extend their help and cooperation towards successful celebration of forthcoming Independence Day/2025. D.C. urged the HODs to take steps for cleanliness of their office premises.
