PROHIBITORY ORDER U/Sec. 163 BNSS, 2023.

Whereas, it has been made to appear to me from reports from concerned departments that Human and animal conflict has been increasing day by day in Golaghat district.

Whereas, uses of any sharp objects/ self-made weapons/ fire crackers or weapons etc. by the people attracts unwanted risk and a cause for imminent threat to wild animals.

And whereas, it has also raised the risk of both human and animal life which mandates the District Magistrate to take steps such as enforcement of prohibitory orders to deter people from using any weapons/ arms/ fire weapons etc. for safety of animals including preventing and accumulation of gathering of public/private persons in the safe animal corridors;

And whereas, unauthorized activity upon the animals leads to accidents and loss of lives and property.

Now, therefore, I, Shri Pulak Mahanta, ACS, District Magistrate, Golaghat, in exercise of powers conferred upon me U/Sec. 163 BNSS, 2023 and in the interest of public health, safety and danger to wildlife, do hereby promulgate the following within the jurisdiction of Golaghat district.

- 1. Prohibition of assembly of five or more person with a common intent of chasing the wild animals.**
- 2. No one can use any kind of sharp objects/Fire Crackers/ arms & ammunition to chase animals.**
- 3. Forest department shall take necessary steps for protection of both human and animal and engage sufficient officials & force for the same.**
- 4. Forest department may take the help of District Administration and Police Administration as and when required.**
- 5. Prohibition of playing of high/loud volume and blowing of loud horns in and around the animal gathering.**
- 6. Uploading of any video contents/photos in social media related to the same may be avoided.**

7. Uses of poison in River, Pond etc. must be avoided which results risk and a cause for imminent threat to wild animals.

This order is passed ex-parte considering the exigencies of the matter.

Any violation of this order shall be punishable under the relevant provision of law.

Any person aggrieved by this order may approach the undersigned for exemption/ alteration etc. of this order. In the event of any violation of this prohibitory order, action will invite prosecution U/Sec. 223 of BNS, 2023 against the violators.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect.
