<u>ORDER</u>

Whereas, the letter vide Memo No. DJ(G).4074/2024, dtd. 27.05.2024 received from the District & Sessions Judge, Golaghat and No. HC.XLV-373(Pt.I)/2021/337/PM&P, dtd. 21.05.2024 received from the Registrar (Admin), Gauhati High Court with a prayer to declare "No Fly Zone" over the Court premises of Golaghat District;

And whereas, it has been brought to my attention that the court premises are deemed sensitive areas requiring heightened security measures to prevent any potential threats or disturbances and conduct of operation of unmanned aerial vehicles (drones) requires to be prohibited within or over the court premises of the court of District Judiciary, Golaghat;

And whereas operation of unmanned aerial vehicles (drones) are source of nuisance in public premises such as courts of the District Judiciary, Golaghat,

And whereas, the District Magistrate is specially empowered under Section 133 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, to remove such nuisance or to desist a person from carrying an act causing nuisance at public places;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Section 133 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, and in the interest of maintaining public order, safety and physical comfort, I, Dr. P. Uday Praveen, IAS, District Magistrate, Golaghat, hereby declare the area specified below as a "No Fly Zone" to desist any person form operating unmanned aerial vehicles (drones):

Specified Area:

• <u>Location: Court Premises of the District Judiciary, Golaghat District,</u>
<u>Assam(includes within and over the premises)</u>

This order will come into force with immediate effect and remain in force until further order.

Any person aggrieved by this order may approach the undersigned for exemption/alteration etc. of this order.

In view of the emergent situation this order is passed ex-parte and addressed to the public in general.

Any violation of these orders shall be dealt with strictly as per section 188 of the Indian Penal code, 1860.
